



1. The British Shooting Remote SCATT Series is an open competition to all athletes wishing to participate in the following categories:
 - 10m Rifle
 - 50m Three Positions
 - 10m Pistol
2. The format of the competition is that each calendar month athletes submit **two** (or more) SCATT based competition series. The best two scores (one per period) will be recorded against the athlete competing. These two scores will be added together to place the competitor into their league position.
 - Period One – 1st – 14th of the month.
 - Period Two – 15th – 30/31st of the month.
3. The scores will be published in league tables on the British Shooting website. The first month's scores will seed the athletes into League 1, League 2 etc.
4. To remain eligible athletes must meet the criteria of submitting scores for each calendar month for both scoring periods. A gap of two periods or more (1 calendar month) will remove that athlete from the league tables.
5. The competition can be fired at any distance using the representative SCATT printed target. Use of either SCATT Basic, or, expert is permissible.
6. The Series competition will run initially until 31st Oct 2020. This will be reviewed at a later date.
7. Prizes will be awarded!
8. The SCATT Series is open to all Olympic, Paralympic, beginner, intermediate or advanced athletes across the international shooting fraternity.
